

- 2 Tours, secured 4 enrollments






- **Front Office Structural Change Proposal**

Proposal: Restructuring of front office staff functions

Purpose: Aim to free up administrators to focus more on supporting teaching and learning activities for teachers and staff in the classroom, which is the main focus at our school.






